John 1:4-5 NIV

In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

John 3:19 NIV

This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil.

John 8:12 NIV

When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

John 9:5 NIV

While I am in the world, I am the light of the world."

Look up John 3:16-21 and read through it today.

God did not send Jesus to condemn people with harsh truth, demanding they believe or else. God recognized the plight of people whom he loves deeply. He saw their hopelessness, heard their cries for help. He even realized many were lost but far from asking for help, too stubborn, too prideful, too hurt. But He sent Jesus anyway, knowing some would ignore or refuse His life-saving help. Grace brings you truth even when you're too angry or stubborn or hurt or lost to look for it. These are the actions of a good God who sacrificed His one and only son to save you. Have you accepted His help? Are you willing to humble yourself, to bend a knee and tell God you're ready for saving and thank Him for his grace and patience as He waited for this very moment in your life?

Watch your life and doctrine closely. Persevere in them, because if you do, you will save both yourself and your hearers.

2 Timothy 2:1b NIV

"...be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus."

Avoid godless chatter, because those who indulge in it will become more and more ungodly.

1 Timothy 1:3-7 NLT

When I left for Macedonia, I urged you to stay there in Ephesus and stop those whose teaching is contrary to the truth. Don't let them waste their time in endless discussion of myths and spiritual pedigrees. These things only lead to meaningless speculations, which don't help people live a life of faith in God. The purpose of my instruction is that all believers would be filled with love that comes from a pure heart, a clear conscience, and genuine faith. But some people have missed this whole point. They have turned away from these things and spend their time in meaningless discussions. They want to be known as teachers of the law of Moses, but they don't know what they are talking about, even though they speak so confidently.

Romans 14:1 NIV

Accept the one whose faith is weak, without quarreling over disputable matters.

John Stott, in his commentary on Romans, says that to accept someone means, "to welcome them into one's fellowship and into one's heart. It implies the warmth and kindness of genuine love."

Romans 14:13 NIV

Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in the way of a brother or sister.

Romans 14:19 NIV

Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification.

First, we are committed to loving those who disagree with us and to protecting the unity of the body of Christ.

Second, our love for each other means that we should be ready to set aside our personal preferences for the sake of the weaker Christian.
