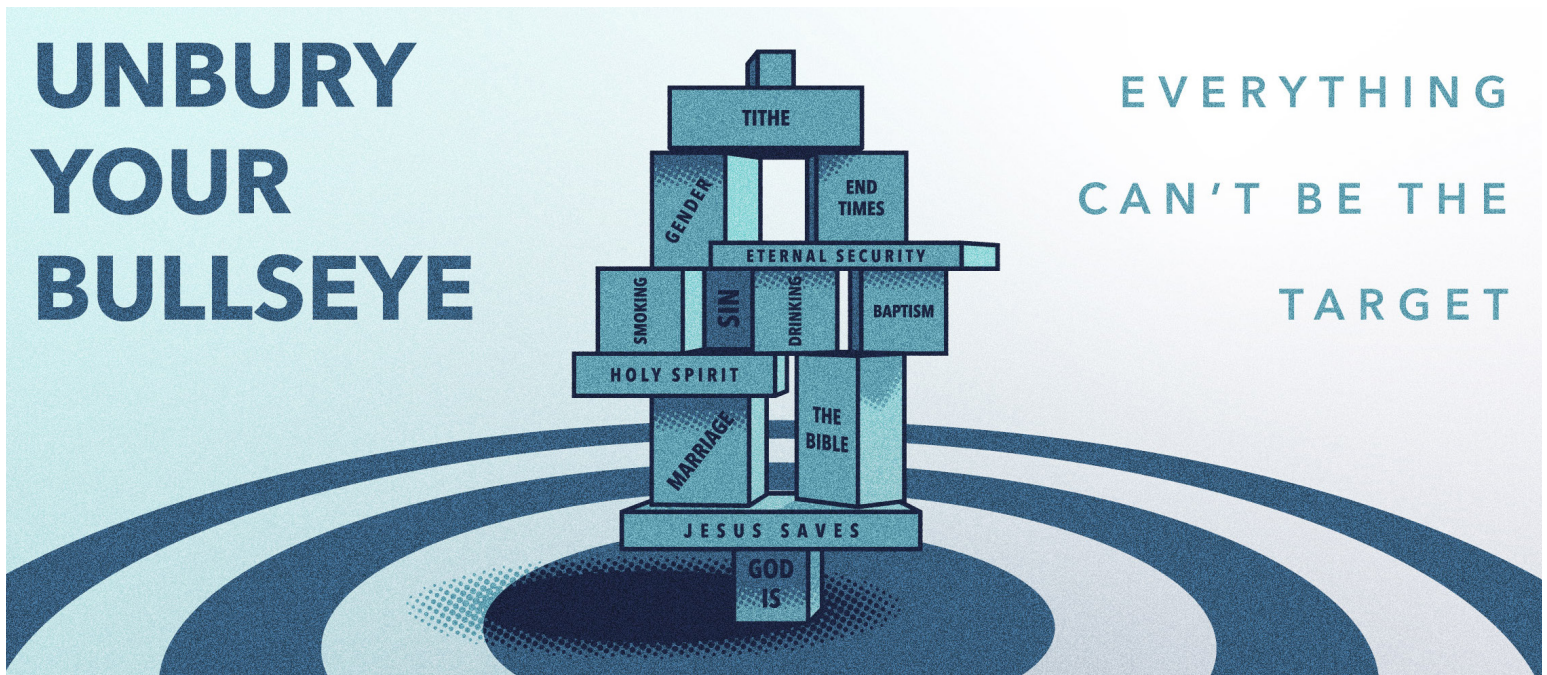

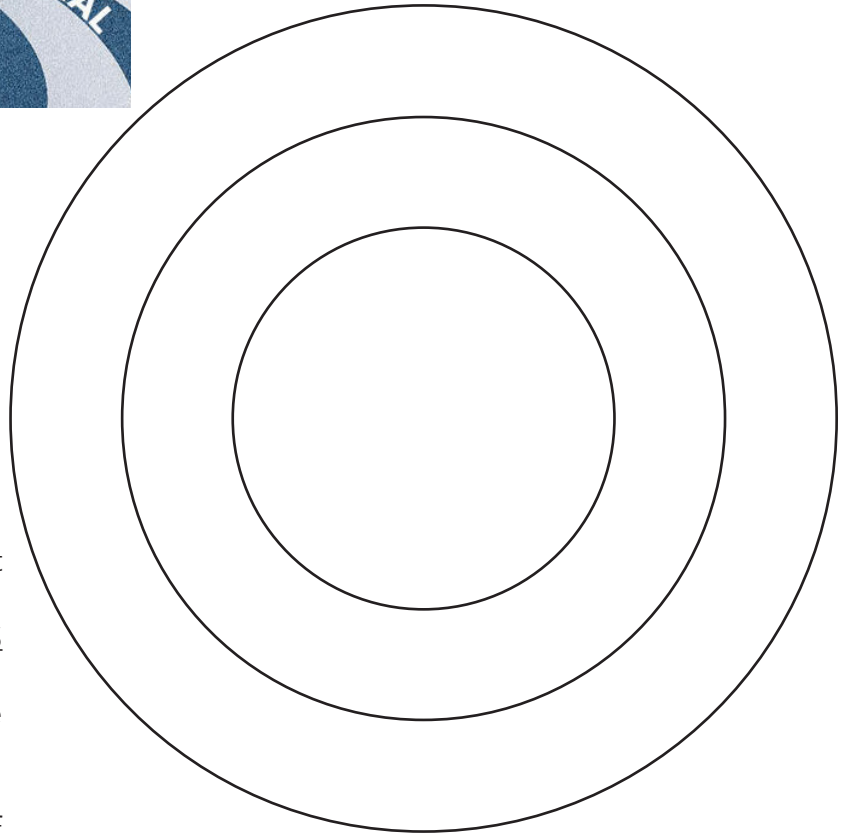
9 ESSENTIAL BELIEFS (in no special order)

Summarized for easier memorization:

1. It is essential that a Christian believes that GOD exists.
2. It is essential that a Christian believes JESUS is Lord and the risen Savior.
3. It is essential that a Christian believes we are born again by the HOLY SPIRIT.
4. It is essential that a Christian believes God was the FATHER of Jesus and revealed himself as the spiritual FATHER of all who put their faith in Him.
5. It is essential that a Christian believes that the BIBLE is God's word to us.
6. It is essential that a Christian believes that all PEOPLE are made in the spiritual image of God.
7. It is essential that a Christian believes that we will exist for ETERNITY with God in heaven or separated from God in hell.
8. It is essential that a Christian believes every Christian is called to FULL TIME Christian service.
9. It is essential that a Christian believes we are SAVED by God's grace through faith and not by any human effort.

Home Group Notes

Pray: It is always good by having someone begin group with prayer and invite the Spirit to join in on your group. (It may help to ask someone else ahead of time, some people like to prepare.)

Intro: Lets start by catching up about the holidays.

- What was highlight of your Christmas/New Years time?
- Did you make any resolutions for this coming year?
- Should our group make any collective resolutions?

Questions: Let's start by taking some time and thinking about our essential beliefs. Write down what you believe is most important and vital to Christianity. Share with each other what you write.

- How do you think sharing essential beliefs with each other helps our relationships?
- Do you have any relationships with people who don't share your essential beliefs? How does it work?
- Are there ways to disagree with any of these essentials and still work together?
- Do you feel your life reflects these essential beliefs? Could you improve?
- How can we help each other?

Pray Again: You can never pray too much, but this is a good time to ask if there are anything the group can be praying for. Leaders, be sure to take some notes and pray for your groups throughout the week. Don't forget to follow up with each other when you see God working and answering prayers.
